UTA Edenred's toll box UTA One® next now supports toll processing in the Czech Republic

- **UTA One® next is the most comprehensive toll device for the European Electronic Toll Service on the market, processing tolls in 18 European countries**
- **On-board unit offers future-proof 4G network compatibility; integrated telematics and parking space booking services available as add-ons**
- **Device also supports the new Dutch toll system launching in July 2026**

Kleinostheim, Germany – UTA Edenred, a leading mobility service provider in Europe and an Edenred company, has expanded its interoperable UTA One® next toll device to include the Czech Republic toll context. With this latest update, the 4G-compatible on-board unit (OBU) for the European Electronic Toll Service (EETS) can process tolls in 18 European countries, making it the most comprehensive EETS OBU on the market.

UTA One next users can activate the Czech toll context immediately in the UTA Service Center and install it via a rapid over-the-air update. Alternatively, the device can be ordered with the context pre-installed.

Pierre Jalady, General Manager Edenred Mobility EMEA and CEO of UTA Edenred, says: “Toll solutions are a key component of our mobility service portfolio. Adding the Czech toll context to our flagship UTA One next device simplifies cross-border mobility even further for our European fleet customers.”

Toll processing in 18 countries and suitable for vehicles over 3.5 tonnes

UTA One next is suitable for vehicles weighing over 3.5 tonnes. In addition to supporting toll settlement in the Czech Republic, the device can process tolls in Germany, France, Italy (including Caronte ferry services), Belgium (including the Liefkenshoek tunnel), Austria, Poland (A4, Katowice – Kraków and the e-TOLL network), Hungary, Bulgaria, Croatia, Slovenia, Slovakia, Portugal, Spain, Norway (including bridges, ferries, tunnels and highways), Sweden (bridges and ferries), Denmark (including bridges and ferries) and Switzerland (including Liechtenstein).

Additional functions: UTA SmartConnect® telematics service and parking space service

UTA One next supports UTA SmartConnect, a telematics service that provides fleet managers with comprehensive data insights related to fleet activities. Users can activate UTA SmartConnect in the UTA Service Center to leverage real-time monitoring, location query and display of the OBU status.

In addition, together with other UTA toll solutions and the UTA Card, UTA One next enables the spontaneous approach and billing of dedicated truck parking spaces across Europe, including secure parking areas.

Outlook: UTA One next compatible with the toll system launching in the Netherlands in July 2026

On 30 June 2026, Eurovignettes will be discontinued as a toll solution in the Netherlands, to be replaced by a new satellite-based toll system. UTA One next is ready to support the new Dutch toll.
